Dr. Theoharis C. Theoharides

Dr. Theoharides is the Director of Molecular Immunopharmacology and Drug Discovery, as well as a Professor of Pharmacology and Internal Medicine at Tufts University and Tufts Medical Center, Boston, MA, USA . He has been placed in the top 1% of authors most cited in pharmacological and immunological journals. Dr. Theoharides was the first to show that certain immune cells, called mast cells known for causing allergic reactions, can be stimulated by non-allergic triggers, such as cytokines, neuropeptides and stress hormones, to secrete inflammatory mediators leading to neuro-inflammation.
